

REMOTE CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS

Creating a Message:

1. Choose a memory key button by pressing the memory key buttons, M0 – M9.
2. Press EDIT and erase the current message by pressing the BACK ARROW/ERASE BUTTON or press the DOWN ARROW to erase the entire message. Always wait for the “.” to appear before typing a message.
3. Use alphanumeric keys to input required message. Press same key quickly to advance through characters, wait 1 second to use the same letter again, or press next required character. To insert a space, press SPACE/RIGHT ARROW. Press SHIFT to lower or upper case the letter. If you make a mistake press the ERASE/BACK ARROW until you have deleted the error; then proceed with your message.
4. To insert a library word or phrase press LIBRARY then followed by the library number ie: 00 - 59. You can insert a standard library phrase anywhere within a custom message. Just pick one from the next page and use the corresponding two digit number.
5. To insert a space, press RIGHT ARROW twice. Press SHIFT to lower or upper case the letter.
6. Once you have completed your message, press STORE; then press the memory key button you would like to use to store your message in (M0 – M9).
7. Your custom message is now stored and can be played any time by pressing that corresponding memory key.
8. Scrolling LED speed can be changed by pressing the SPEED button and using the up and down arrows.

Note – Up to 80 Characters can be preprogrammed into memory locations; however, the total sum of the messages stored cannot exceed 470.
